

## PARENTAL GUIDELINES

### Parent(s)

- must abide by all school policies, procedures, and regulations while visiting any campus, classroom, or anywhere any school sponsored activity is being held.
- must cooperate with school officials in the school's effort to provide your child with a quality education in a safe and secure environment.
- will be responsible for your child being in dress code; including hair cut and hair style, each and every day.
- must follow all traffic flow patterns, rules, and instructions while picking up or dropping off your child, and exercise extreme caution while in the school's Pick-up/Drop-off Zone (also called the No Phone Zone).
- are not to exhibit negative or offensive behavior either verbally or by your actions while in attendance at athletic events, sports functions or any school sponsored activity.
- must cooperate with school officials in the school's effort to discipline your child according to the standards outlined in the Texas Education Code and the Advantage Academy "Student Code of Conduct".
- will at no time make any type threat toward a school administrator, principal or other school staff member, verbally, in writing, or by any other means of communication or action.
- will at no time make false accusations toward or against any school employee, school campus or the school district itself.
- parents/Guardians will be notified of their violation(s) by mail.
- all violations of the **"Parental Guidelines"** are at the discretion of school administrators.
- all violations will be fully documented and placed along with the student's permanent records.
